IMPACT OF THESE CUTS:

- 60,000 working families face job loss due to lack of access to affordable child care



- Over \$250,000,000 will be lost to child care providers throughout California, closing small businesses and forcing thousands of additional Californians into unemployment.



On October 8, Governor Schwarzenegger eliminated all funding for Stage 3 child care, jeopardizing the economic stability and lives of over 81,000 children in California. These families have weathered difficult times to obtain and retain jobs and provide for their families. For many, Stage 3 child care assistance is the only financial support they receive. Without it, these parents stand to lose their jobs or face leaving their children unsupervised. Together, Speaker John Perez and Senate Pro-Tem Darrell Steinberg have vowed to introduce legislation in early December to fully restore Stage 3 funding. We applaud these efforts.
