Our Mission:

Family Resource & Referral Center provides child and youth development services that promote family well-being

- ◆ **5,972 Families and 12,752 Children** benefited from financial assistance with child care costs.
- ◆ **1,087 Parents/Child Care Providers and 136 Teachers** attended 134 workshops and training sessions offered by FRRRC.
- ◆ **5,537 Children** received healthy meals and snacks through the Child Care Food Program.
- ◆ **3,844 Individuals** visited our Resource Center.
- ◆ **3,121 Attended** Children and Youth Day.
- ◆ **9 Honorees** were recognized at the 23rd Action on Behalf of Children (ABC) Awards Ceremony.



Family Resource & Referral Center is a critical link to quality child care services for all parents, child care providers, and children in San Joaquin County and the surrounding area.

The agency embraces diversity as an essential component in the way we deliver services — 86% of staff are of minority descent and 57% speak at least one language in addition to English.



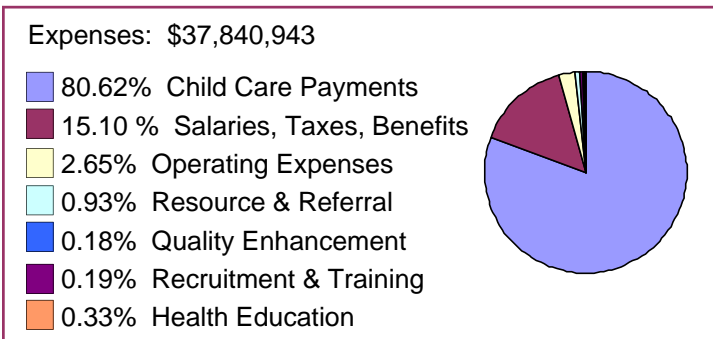
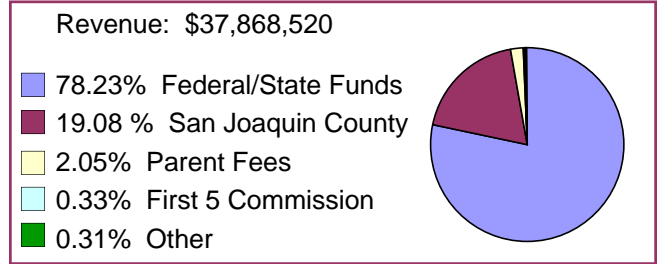
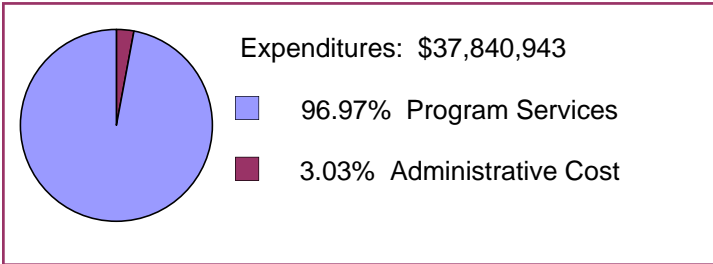
- ◆ **1,223 Children** were referred by FRRRC to child care and preschool programs in San Joaquin County.
- ◆ **60 Environment Rating Scale Assessments** were conducted for child care homes, centers and preschools to help providers measure and improve the quality of their programs.
- ◆ **5,430 Parents, Providers and Community Members** receive our newsletter *In A Nutshell*.
- ◆ **\$31 Million** was spent to provide child care services for children and families.
- ◆ **160 Individuals** received CPR and First Aid Training.
- ◆ **159 Families** received 1,139 home visits from FRRRC's health educators.
- ◆ **50 Child Care Professionals** were honored at our Provider Appreciation Day event co-sponsored by the SJC Family Child Care Association.
